



Active Shooter Instructor Course (LE)

Upon successful completion of this three day course, the student will be able to instruct other law enforcement officers on how to respond to an Active Shooter Incident. The student will be able to teach the history of past incidents, law enforcement's response and what future trends could develop. The student will be able to set-up and conduct an Active Shooter practical exercise and then critique the performance of those being taught.

Pre-requisites

Students must be DCJS General Instructors

Students should be experienced trainers in their department

Students should have a basic understanding of an Active Shooter Response

Day 1

- Students will be taught the powerpoint presentation, "History and Trends of an Active Shooter Incident"
- Students will review and discuss previous incidents and what tactics did and did not work.
- Students will learn/review NIMS/ICS techniques
- Students will work a table top exercise on how to set up and respond to an active shooter incident.
- Students will be taught the basic tactics of an active shooter response.

Day 2

- Students will learn and practice Officer Down Rescues (Mounted and Dismounted)
- Students will learn and practice Hallway Movements
- Students will learn and practice Clearing Stairways
- Students will learn and practice Clearing Rooms
- Students will participate in practical exercises and critique themselves on their performance
- Students will act as trainers

Day 3

- Students will create a lesson plan for an Active Shooter presentation
- Students will give a presentation on Active Shooter Response (Assigned)
- Students will conduct a practical exercise and critique their peers. (Assigned)
