

Tac Carbine I Course

This one-day course is designed to teach the new carbine rifle owners how to correctly utilize their weapon system. Students will learn proper firearms handling and then practice those techniques on the range. The goal of the course is to make the students confident in their ability to shoot their carbine rifle. The topics that will be covered include:

- Firearm mechanics and terminology
- Fundamentals of marksmanship
- Proper Sighting and Zeroing
- Shooting / Carry positions
- Reloads / Malfunction drills

Required Equipment:

Eye Protection (wrap-around style) Ear Protection

Carbine with sling 500 rounds of ammunition
Three magazines (No green tip or armor piercing)

Magazine retention system (vest, belt, chest harness, etc.)

Recommended Equipment:

Cold/ Wet Weather Gear (as appropriate) Brimmed hat

Note book w/ writing utensil Loose fitting clothing (no shorts)

Cleaning kit Camelback or similar

Knee & elbow pads
