



Low Light Pistol Course

This one day course is designed for pistol owners to become more proficient in utilizing their weapon system in a low light environment. Class will begin with a lecture on human performance in a low light environment, followed by different techniques to use a handheld light with your pistol. The focus of the course is home defense and concealed carry in a low light environment.

Topics Covered-

- Primary and Secondary light selection
- Physiology of low light engagements
- Proper light usage
- Handheld lights and shooting
- Low Light Theory

Required Equipment:

Eye Protection (wrap around style)	Ear Protection
Pistol w/ waist or thigh holster (NO chest rigs)	300 rounds of ammunition
Two flashlights (handheld and/or weapon mounted)	Two magazines*
Magazine retention system (vest, belt, chest harness, etc.)	

Recommended Equipment:

Cold/ Wet Weather Gear (as appropriate)	Brimmed hat
Note book w/ writing utensil	Loose fitting clothing (no shorts)
Cleaning kit	Camelback or similar
Knee pads / Elbow pads	Batteries for flashlights

Class Size: 10 students
